





Artists and their releases

As 2025 comes to a close, we keep track of a total of 1098 artists of which 245 are women. They grew 46 and 49 percent respectively.

In 2025 there were 1343 releases with a total of 2724 tracks, reflecting the 100 albums released this year. Releases grew 16,38% and total songs released grew 22,10% compared to 2024.

This is also reflected in the total hours of Cypriot music released, which in 2025 amassed to 162 hours (+20,9%), or almost a full week.

Solo women are now 22,31% of all recording Cypriot artists, up from 21,87% in 2024. Mix-gendered duo/groups are 2,4% of all artists.




Solo women represent 22,31% of all Cypriot artists

Six Cypriot producers and writers

Making waves in Cyprus and internationally. Cypriot writers and producers were a part of more than 45 non-Cypriot releases in 2025: *a majority of them for women!*

Bluegirl (Phoebe Xenofontos) produced songs on Déyyess' both EPs in 2025, a single by Jack Kane and received funding from PRS to upgrade her home studio! She has had sessions with Daydreamers, Ross MacDonald (The 1975), Nxdia, Lucy Blue, total tommy, while also writing and producing her own upcoming project.



GOKO! (Gökberk Çirakoğlu) has in 2025 produced two songs for Turkish Popstar Simge and the collab between UZI & Motive - which also hit *number 1 in Cyprus* upon release. Goko! has also co-written one song with Erzurumlu for Masal.

Christian Cherry (Zenonas Yianni) has not only writing his own upcoming EP, but also for Tamta, Demy, Nikolas Raptakis and Teo.x3 in 2025, and his collaboration with Teo.x3 got editorial playlisted in the UK in November as well as sprite (performed by Tamta & Teo.x3) in December. In late November he released highly anticipated single "Home Depot", off his upcoming EP and its' music video made waves on Twitter, including a tweet by PopTingz.



2025 has been a busy year for **Mr.Foxy** (Andreas Konstantinou). He released his 5th album "Breaking Bread", executive produced Yotan's debut album "Red Fox", Nicksie's debut single 'PROMISES' and a single across the ocean, New York City's own Abby Helms and her single "i think i am". Overall Mr.Foxy was a part of over 20 releases in 2025.

In 2025, **Tolga Erzurumlu** has stayed busy with Turkish RnB newcomer Masal, producing and/or writing every single of hers this year! Erzurumlu also released an Afro remix in collaboration with Kenan Doglu in February; remixing has long been part of Erzurumlu's career, including a track on Buray's third album.



ody icons (Odysseas Konstantinou) has in 2025 written Demy and Theo Evan's collaboration, for Tamta and Demy (occasionally along with Christian Cherry), and Yianna Terzi. In December 2025 he released a collaborative album with Christos K. Theodorou.

Back to... Folk

In 2025, one of the biggest trends by Cypriot artists was to remake traditional songs (Cypriot and international).

Some notable examples are Alejjos' & Stephanos Pelekanis' remake of Loulla Mou, Maroulla Mou into a modern club track (**LOULLA**), Elena Papapanagiotou who pop-ified Tillyrkotissa/Dillirga (**TRIALALA**) and Buray who covered folk songs over four EPs.

It is a sign of appreciation of those that came before and a desire to teach the next generation about classic [Cypriot] songs, and that they are not only meant to be played at events.



Bruno Mars and BLOK3 had two songs each in the top 4. 'git' was the only 2025 release in the top 5. Ioulia Kallimani was the only Greek woman in the top 40 and one of four in the entire top 100. APT. is the first K-pop song to be the most streamed song of the year.

"**Se Periptosi Pou**" continued its' reign in 2025, and easily became the most streamed Cypriot song in Cyprus 2025 (and was the 11th overall!). AIMS' single "**Need Somebody**" off the album "**PEAK SEASON**" became the most streamed 2025 Cypriot release.

Cypriot Digital Chart

The Cypriot Digital Chart, published weekly, and the Digital Chart: Cypriots Edition that published monthly celebrated 4 years and 16 months respectively in December.

Anna Vissi made chart history by becoming the first Cypriot to chart *four songs simultaneously* on the Digital Chart, and she did on three separate occasions! While GOKO! co-produced one of the biggest number 1s on the Cypriot Digital Chart ever. UZI and Motive's Şarkılar Sokaklara Ait had the 3rd biggest debut week for a Turkish-language song in the chart in its' four year history!

On the Cypriot exclusive chart, 42 new songs and 16 artists charted for the first time. This meant that the total songs to have ever charted more than doubled (+168%) while the artists grew 100%.

Language breakdown per genre

English and Hip-hop/rap remains the two biggest language and genre respectively from Cypriot artists. The most releases (in absolute numbers) in both Greek and Turkish are also from hip-hop/rap releases, while instrumental releases are over-represented from Electronic releases (as seen in the table on the right).

Solo Cypriot women primarily make pop and RnB / Soul. In 2025, they released 189 releases, of which 11 were debut singles, 6 debut EPs and 1 debut album. Women also sing more in other languages compared to men, while men release more bilingual releases.

Mixed gendered artists released 2 debut singles and 2 debut albums.





October was the biggest release month in total numbers, having over 146 individual releases, which led to Q4 becoming the biggest quarter of 2025.


The second half 2025 had 85 more releases than the first (+13,5%).

Releases averaged 112 individual releases per month, or 26 per New Music Friday.

However, the most popular Friday to release was February 28th with 41 unique releases and the least was January 3rd with 9.





Only 3 months had less than 100 releases and they are start with "J"; January, June and July

Hip-hop / rap releases represented 32% of all releases in 2025, almost 1 out of every 3rd release. Electronic and Pop releases kept up a good fight, amassing to 23 and 16% respectively. Folk grew compared to 2024 as did Alternative.


New Music Friday and genre playlists

One of the main objectives of 'Cypriot Music' is to promote and curate Cypriot music across all genres for listeners, with New Music Friday being the most appreciated by audiences.


In 2025 there were 48 New Music Friday covers, with 3 debut singles, 2 debut EP:s, and 1 debut album being spotlighted. There were 16 solo women, 2 mixed gendered, 3 duo men and 22 solo men featured on the cover.

We have also supported debut releases with featured covers on Cypriot Pop, Cypriot Rock, Cypriot Folk and Made in Cyprus.


Distribution of gender on NMF cover


